EDWARD J. PHILLIPS, PE, CMC is President of The Sims Consulting Group, Inc. and Vice-President of Strategos. Mr. Phillips received his Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering Degree, magna cum laude, from Villanova University, where he graduated first in his class, and his MBA degree from Widener University (formerly Pennsylvania Military College). He is a Registered Professional Engineer in three States, a Chartered Engineer (CEng) in the United Kingdom, and a Certified Management Consultant (CMC).

Mr. Phillips has a broad and diverse background in manufacturing operations. He has worked aerospace, electronics, high volume component manufacturing, machinery production, assembly, and consumer products. He has held engineering and management positions with several Fortune 500 firms including Boeing, TRW, and Motorola.
